


1 EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION

Vivace **VCI10-UH** communication interface provides connection of any HART® device based on the standard FSK frequency modulation (frequency-shift keying) with personal computers (PC), via USB (universal serial bus) port.

VCI10-UH does not require external power, since it uses power from PC USB port directly and enables user to power HART® device when in stand-alone mode, providing voltage or current supply (for conventional transmitters or valve positioners, respectively). The interface has a built-in internal 250 Ohm load to help communication with transmitter HART® modem.

Compatible with all HART® devices, VCI10-UH enables manufacturer interoperability for devices and systems, working with any configuration software which uses USB port for communication with HART® network.



1.1. IDENTIFICATION

VCI10-UH communication interface has a front label indicating the functions of available configuration switches: Pwr (power supply for HART[®] device) and Out (voltage or current output).

This label also has identification of model, manufacturer, communication protocol and device serial number.

Three LEDs indicate if power and communication are present on the interface.

User must also pay attention on connection polarity to device. For this reason, positive pole is represented by the red connector while negative pole is represented by the black connector.

The main technical and physical characteristics of VCI10-UH are listed below on Table 1.1. Those are important references which must be evaluate before product usage.



1.3. HOUSING DIMENSION






Figure 1.2 – VCI10-UH housing dimensions.



2 CONFIGURATION

2.1. CONNECTION

VCI10-UH connection is defined by two switches located on its frontal side: **Pwr** and **Out**. Pwr switch configures the interface to power supply the device it is attached to, when switched to "On". When switched to "Off", device must be powered externally. Figures 2.1 and 2.2 show both connection configurations, with Pwr switched to "Off" and to "On", respectively.



ATTENTION!

Interface must be connected to one device at a time when working as a power supply. Do not connect it on *multidrop* networks (several devices on the same bus).

Note that when using the configuration to power the device externally, the connection of a 250 Ohm serial communication load is necessary (figure 2.1).

The second switch on the interface (Out) is only considered when Pwr is switched to "On". Out switch defines if power will be supplied as voltage (24 Vdc, position "V", for transmitters) or current (3.9 mA, position "mA", for valve positioners), depending on device type.



2.2. CONNECTING TO COMPUTER

On recent versions of operational systems, the interface driver will be installed automaticaly, since computer is connected to the internet. In order to execute the manual installation, user must download the driver file on Vivace website (www.vivaceinstruments.com.br).




Figure 2.4 – Virtual COM port created for VCI10-UH.

After driver installation (Figure 2.3), operational system will allocate a virtual COM port to communicate with USB port. To identify the virtual COM port associated to the interface, user must access "Ports (COM and LPT)" directory inside "Device Manager" on operational system, as shown on Figure 2.4.

User must use this port for HART® communication on software configuration using VCI10-UH.
